

WEEKENDER AT CAMP


Orange River

THE DRIVE

Vioolsdrift is situated on the South African side of the border between South Africa and Namibia. It is a distance of 690 km from Cape Town on the tarred N7.

DIRECTIONS

Fiddlers Creek Campsite, the base camp for Bushwhacked Outdoor Adventures is situated on a small farm on the South African Bank of the Orange River, just 10 km from the border post on the gravel road.



ARRIVAL DAY

Meet at Fiddlers Creek Campsite for the first night at camp where we will have dinner prepared for you. You will meet your guide and he/she will have a quick briefing on how the trip will work.

DAY 1

We will serve breakfast at camp. After breakfast you will be transported up to the put in point that is about 14 kilometres upstream from our campsite. Once you have arrived, your guide will assist you with the boats and do a safety speech. You will spend the day on the water. You are welcome to bring your camera along. Sit back, relax and enjoy the birdlife on the Orange River. You will have time to stop and swim. Halfway through the trip your guide will stop and serve lunch on the water. After lunch, you will hop back in the boat and enjoy the rest of the day on the water.

We will end in the afternoon and we will take out at our campsite. Dinner will be served at camp and we will spend the night at camp.

DAY 2

Breakfast will be served at camp. After breakfast, we will start paddling at our campsite and go further downstream to enjoy another relaxing day. 'Jumprock' will be waiting for the brave! Also, a full day of paddling with lunch included. In the afternoon when we reach our destination, a vehicle will be waiting or us to take us back to our campsite where you set on your journey home. If you would like to stay another night, we can organise camping and catering for you.
